The Issuer continued its business developing proprietary, non-invasive, and accurate cancer diagnostic solutions which can help detect, monitor and assess treatment for cancer early and cost effectively.

The management team prepared an Expression Of Interest proposal for review with an association based in Manitoba for a multiyear co- founding program slated for 2017. The proposal will be submitted in late January 2017.

External private funding discussions with several parties are ongoing with potential due diligence to commence shortly.

BioMark submitted a joint application with Saint Boniface Research Centre following a call for proposal by Diagnostics Services Manitoba for research and innovation on December 9th. 2016. There will be 2 major grants of \$60,000 and 4 small research grants of \$15,000 each offered over a 2 year research project. Winners are expected to be announced in April 2017.

Results of the specific signatures for breast cancer samples is being analyzed and additional samples will be required to confirm and revalidate the panel of markers with The Metabolomics Innovation Centre (TMIC). Additional samples will be tested in January/February 2017.

Management is also seeking additional board members/advisors to with strong scientific and clinical commercialization capabilities. Announcements will be made as new board members and advisors are recruited.
